Spring is a time of renewal, a time of new things...flowers blooming, trees blossoming, grass growing, rain...hopefully not snow....and most importantly for Christians – EASTER!

This year Easter is on April 16!

Easter is so much like Spring in a very important way. Before we get to Spring we first have to go through Winter. Winter tends to be cold, snowy & gray in Michigan.

To get to Easter we have to go through Lent. Lent is a season of reflection...time for Christians to think of what Christ gave for us.

Before Easter we have Lent and Holy Week. We begin Holy Week with Palm Sunday. This year we will emphasize Palm Sunday vs. Passion Sunday.

Next is Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. Both are days that help us understand what it is God did for us through His Son.

On Saturday, we celebrate the Easter Vigil. (at Antioch Lutheran)
Finally, we have EASTER SUNDAY! A time to rejoice! In the resurrection of our Lord.

We must remember that Easter is much more than one day...it is an entire season – 7 Sundays! We have 7 weeks to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord. What a WONDERFUL time for Christians!

April 9 Service @ 10 am

The service begins with a palm procession, commemorating Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Quickly the tone of the service changes as we meditate upon Jesus' passion and death.



April 13 Service @ 12 noon

The Love Feast, or Agape Meal, is a Christian fellowship meal recalling the meals Jesus shared with disciples during his ministry and expressing the community, sharing, and fellowship enjoyed by the family of Christ.



April 14 Service @ 7 pm

At the heart of the Good Friday liturgy is the passion according to John, which proclaims Jesus as a triumphant king who reigns from the cross. The ancient title for this day—the triumph of the cross—reminds us that the church gathers not to mourn this day but to celebrate Christ's life-giving passion and to find strength and hope in the tree of life.

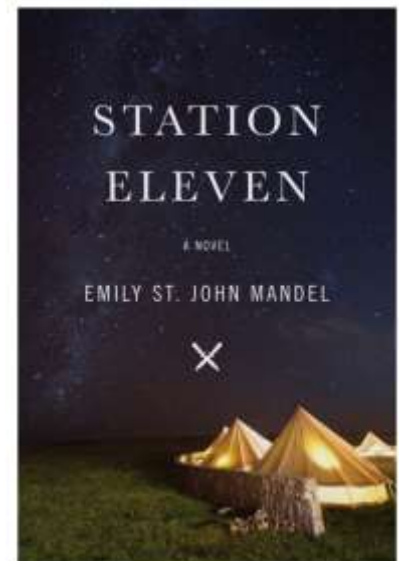
