PASTOR'S ARTICLE

LENT 2025

"In the sincerest silence of my soul, I murmured over and over, 'I love you, Lord Jesus.'

Jesus was dying. I could do nothing to save him - not even to ease him. I could only watch and suffer the sorrow too. I was a child. Yet I saw every detail of his passion exactly as the Bible set it down. Everything! I learned everything. Not because I was precocious, but because I felt it all.

And always there came the moment when I burst into tears.

Jesus looked at me. The love in his face was so horrible that I started to cry, and I murmured over and over, 'I love you, too! I love you, Lord Jesus.'

Did he hear me? At the moment I couldn't know, because he was dying.

Now I know.

He heard me."

The above words come from the preface of a book that I read some years ago, entitled, "Reliving the Passion", and was written by noted ELCA author, Walter Wangerin Jr.

The subtitle is "Meditations on the suffering death and resurrection of Jesus as recorded in Mark."

It is an appropriate book to read during the season of Lent.

The quote that begins this article describes an experience the author had when he was eight years old. He grew up in North Dakota where his father was a Lutheran Pastor.

This experience obviously stayed with him all of his life.

What experiences of Lent do you hold close to your heart? Do you remember Lenten seasons long ago that touched you deeply?

During this season of contemplating our lives, and deaths, as we remember what our Lord did for us on the cross, may we remember those words that Walter sang as a boy, "I love you Lord Jesus!"
